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A new era

Changes to the structures to sixth form studies

Previously: Stepped system

- Year 12 AS choose 4 subjects.
- Year 13 A2 continue with 3 to create a combination of AS and A2 grades and tariff scores.

From 2017: Continuous system

- Year 12 AS qualifications no longer have a tariff at the end of 1 year.
- Year 13 to continue with 3 A levels
