A four tier grading structure that ensures all our students receive appropriate recognition for their efforts:

Exam has total of 70 marks.

- 20 marks needed in exam for C grade
- 30 marks needed in exam for B grade
- 40 marks needed in exam for A grade
- 50 marks needed in exam for A* grade
