

Year 8 Computing – “World Tour”

These are key units that require teaching. There are links to year 9 teaching units, so will need completing in their entirety.

The ‘begin’ a scheme is the minimum expectation for progress with a class. If a scheme has been completed and summative assessments carried out, then flexibility exists in the scheme for the class to progress at their own speed, depending on class ability.
