Dear Year 11 Parent/ Carers,

It is my great pleasure to share with you information regarding the GCSE summer examinations for 2024. I am extremely excited about students sitting GCSE examinations following a hardworking and productive year so far. Students and staff have been working extremely hard towards this moment, and I know that the students are going to make us all even prouder than we already are.

Written examinations take place from Monday 13th May to Monday 24th June. There are also a number of practical examinations taking place before this date in Art, Design, Catering, Drama and Music. These dates are available on the students' Teams platform and will be shared as soon as they are finalised.

Before this, we have our final set of PPEs (mock exams) starting week commencing 12th February. These exams are essential as they provide a real opportunity for students to test where they are up to with their revision and allows staff to focus in on the areas to support your child before the summer examinations. It is essential that students attend all of these exams to help support them moving forward. Students will receive their personalised PPE timetable by the end of this week.

As an Academy, we want to provide the best support for your child in the build up to their exams. As part of this, we are providing **compulsory** after school examination support sessions. As part of these sessions, we will be completing targeted work with some students to support them in the areas they found difficult in the last set of exams. Letters will be sent out shortly for these targeted sessions, and we would really appreciate your support in students attending these sessions to help maximise their potential.
