# **Key Information**

All aspects of the course are assessed within two closed book examinations as there is no controlled assessment within the new examination framework. Students must learn Macbeth and Jekyll and Hyde for their paper 1 examination and must learn An Inspector Calls and the poems within the conflict and power section of their anthology for paper 2. No texts will be provided in the examination, so students are expected to have a detailed understanding of each of these texts.
