The GCSE Product Design paper is 2 hours long and everyone sits the same paper.

- There are 120 marks on offer
- You will be given a pre-release theme sheet before the exam. It is usually available after 1<sup>st</sup> March in the year of the examination
- The paper is divided into 2 sections.
- Section A is designing worth approximately 30 marks
- Section B covers the rest of the specification and is worth approximately 90 marks

You are to answer ALL the questions on the paper.
