## Results Day - Thursday 20th August.

I can now share the arrangements for Results Day, which due to the current situation have had to be revised in line with Government guidelines. We will be allocating time slots for collection based on form groups, this allows us to minimise the number of students on site at any given time. The table below indicates the time slot allocated to each form group, therefore it is imperative this is adhered to, to ensure the correct results envelopes are available.

Key staff will also be there, available for one-to-one personal discussions, and to support you as needed. However all arrangements will be in accordance with the necessary social distancing measures.
