- Charity and voluntary work; healthy and unhealthy living
- Environment; poverty and homelessness
- Holidays and travel; regions of France

Theme 3: Current and future study and employment

- School and subjects; life at school and college
- Education post 16; jobs, career choices and ambitions

Key ingredients for success:

Sentences, use of VCOP, several tenses, opinions, justifications, contrast, intensifiers, comparison, wide range of vocabulary, wide range of structures.

Remember to answer questions in the CORRECT language!

Golden rules for Listening and Reading exams:

- Make the very most of the 5 minutes reading paper time before completing the Listening and Reading exams.
- Remember the 4 steps:
 - Circle the task title which will focus your brain on the topic covered in that task.
 - Read the questions carefully, anticipating possible responses.
 - Then listen to audio/read the text.
 - Then back to question.
- Write clearly and don't give alternative choice of answers: examiners won't choose the right answer for you!

• Underline/circle key phrases to help you secure understanding. Never leave a blank: even if you don't know, chance may be on your side that day.
