Parent Forum Summary 2nd February 2023



Points Discussed:

Homework

Mrs V Davies, Assistant Principal, shared with Parents/Carers the new homework policy and plan. This will be launched with students after the half term holiday. Summary of the new homework plan is as follows:

WFA Homework Expectations (KS3):

• Homework will be set in core subjects (English, Maths, and Science) weekly. The total amount of time for each student should not exceed 1hr per subject (3hrs in total for each student).

English – homework will be set on Reading Progress on Teams.

Maths – homework will be set on MathsWatch.

Science – homework will be set on Seneca Learning.

- Homework set by other subjects will be set of Reading Progress on Teams or on Bedrock Learning and will not exceed 2hrs per subject each half term.
- All homework will be set centrally in subject areas and will be an extension of learning, linked closely to the curriculum. Homework will be set on the relevant learning platform and a notification will be sent on ClassCharts.

WFA Homework Expectations (KS4/KS5):

- Revision based homework will be set in all subject areas weekly. The total amount of time for each student should not exceed 1hr per subject per week at KS4.
- Types of homework may include:
 - o GCSE Pod
 - Seneca Learning
 - MathsWatch
 - Completion of revision booklet/revision guides
 - Exam questions
 - Wider reading
 - Reading Progress on Teams
 - o Revision activities (flashcards, quizzes, knowledge organisers, revision clocks, etc.)
 - Independent study

At KS5 students will be supported and encouraged to work independently in their study periods. Work set will directly support the curriculum and prepare students for further and higher education.

Attendance

Mrs J Watson, Deputy Principal, explained that since the last Parent Forum the new Attendance Policy is now on the school website and all staff have had training on it. Students will have an update on Attendance through assemblies and individual attendance for students is a focus in every tutor time.
