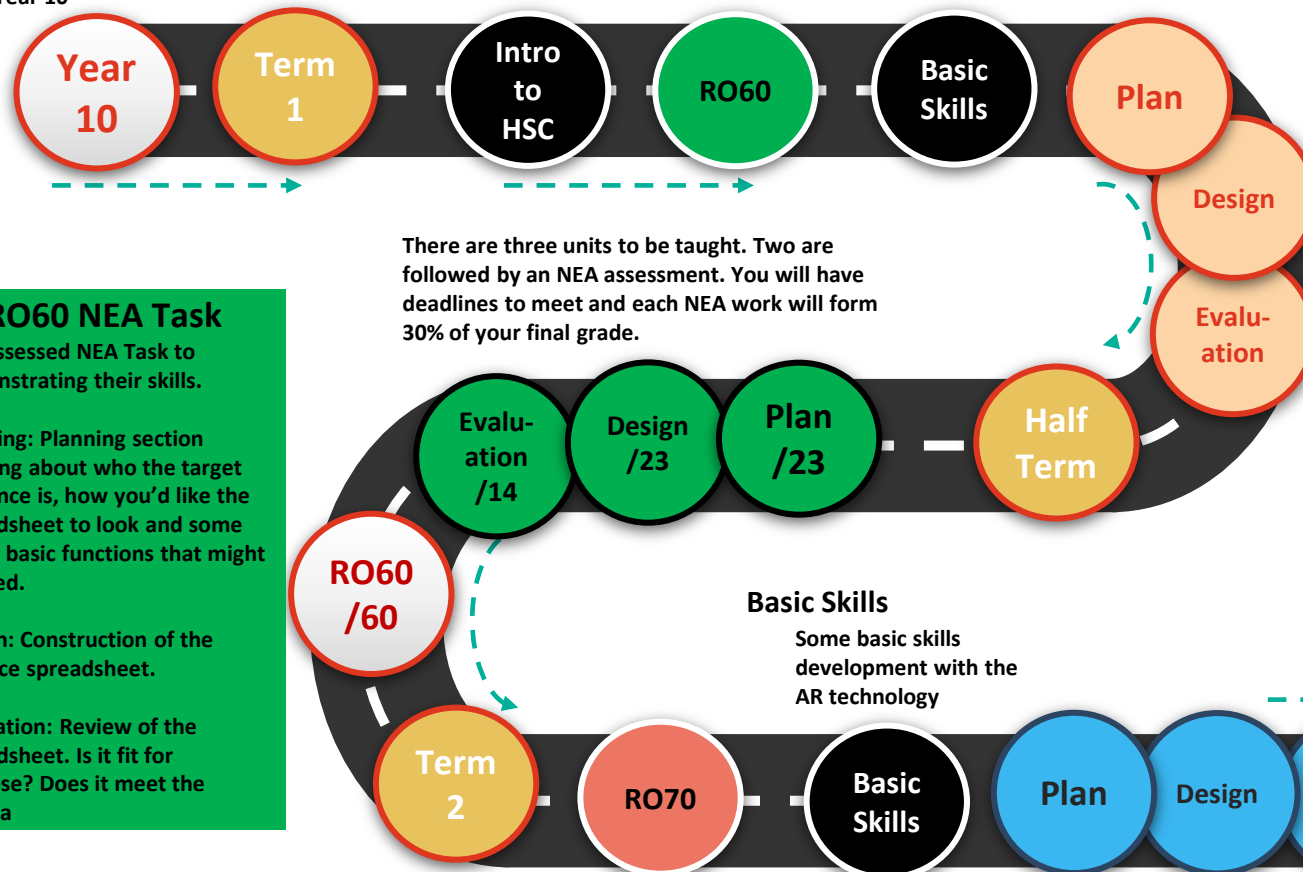

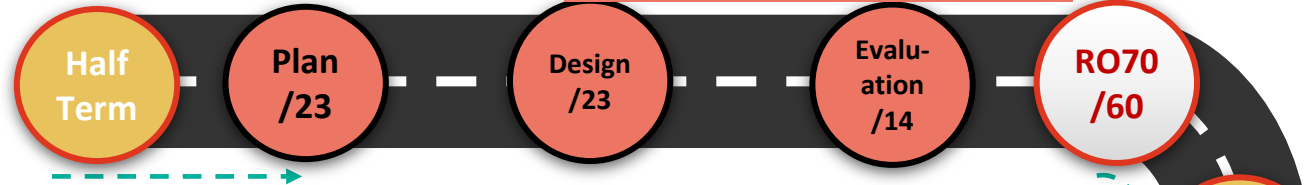

RO70 NEA Task

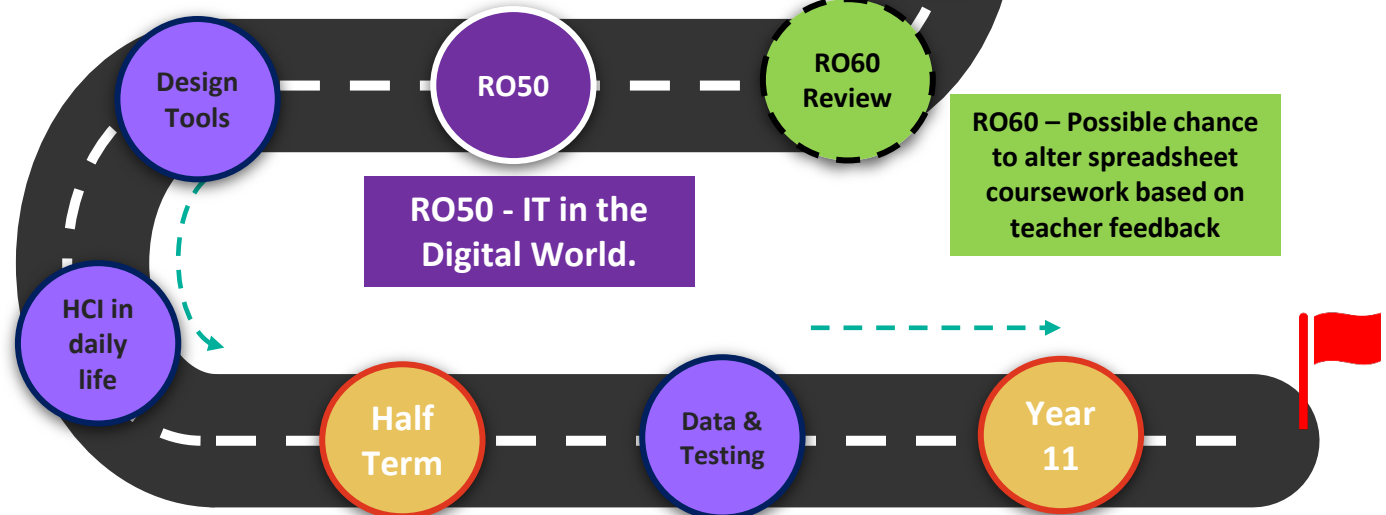
The assessed NEA Task to demonstrating their skills.

These are delivered in a more traditional lesson format.

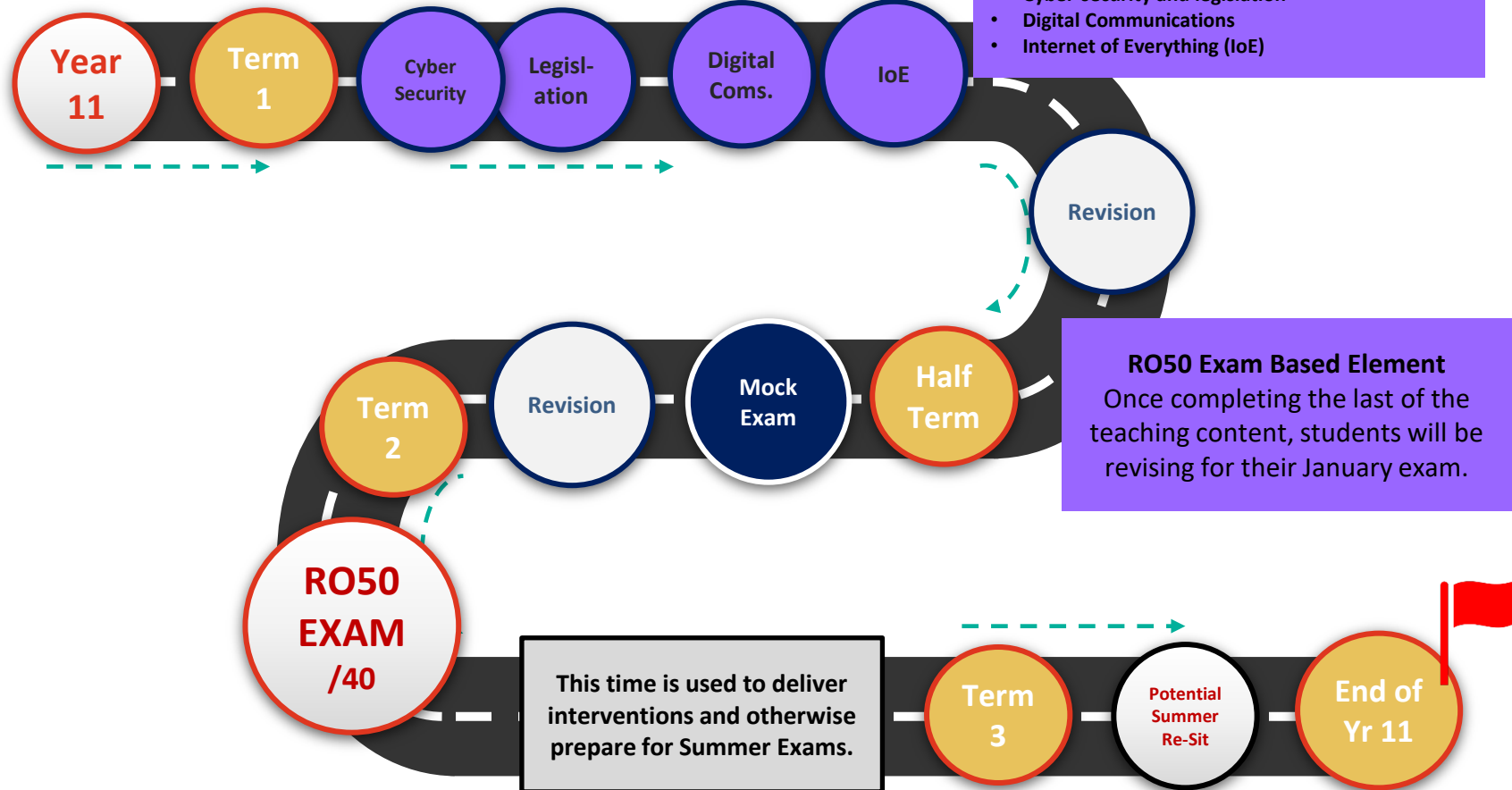
Most of the teaching content is delivered in the summer of year 10 which allows for maximum revision time in Year 11.
