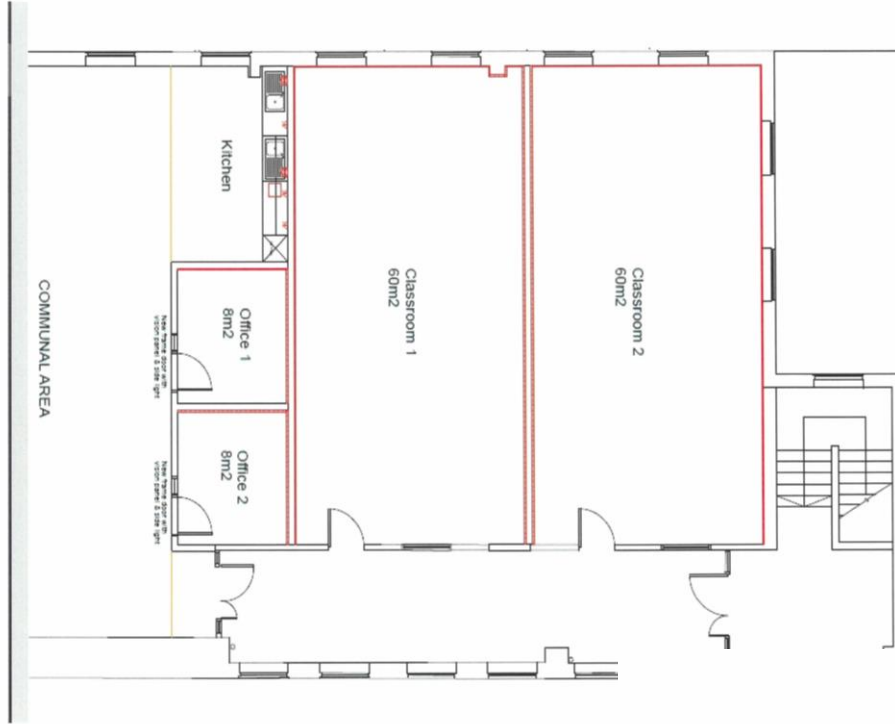

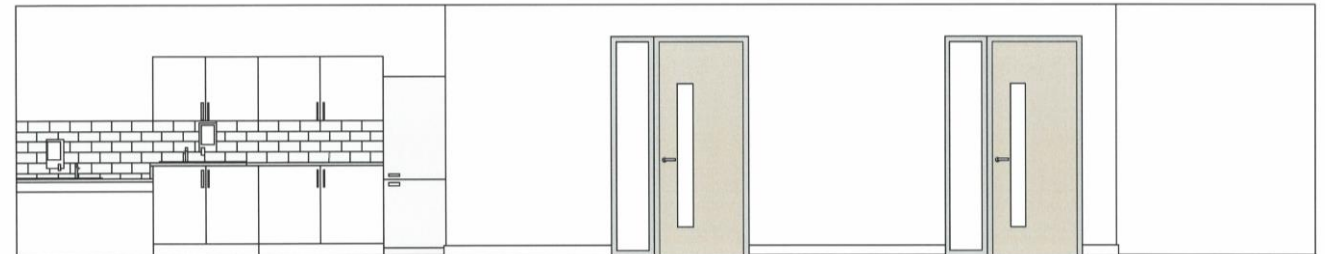

Mrs Souster: Our course offer ...

- All courses are Level 3
- Most Level 3 courses take two years
- You will need 5 grades at GCSE Grade '5+', including English Language and Mathematics
- However, there are specific grade requirements for some courses at 'Grade 6 and above'
- You must check the Course Guide for each course's entry requirement
- Most students will study 3 full Level 3 courses
- Following individual guidance some students may study a fourth which could include Further Maths or an EPQ



... and what is required of you?

- We are a Sixth Form community; you attend a standard school day
- Independent Study is essential, allow 4-5 hours each week, for each subject, on top of your class learning
- You must be a dedicated learner: no more than 8 hours in part-time work outside of school
- 96% minimum attendance
- Proud to be a young professional in attitude, values and appearance



WFA Sixth Form Application Timeline

25 January 2024:

- Sixth Form Open Evening, meeting students, staff, receiving independent guidance
- Alternative Prospectus 'By students, for students' launched
- New Sixth Form videos launched on website featuring student testimonies

26 January 2024:

- 2024 Sixth Form Application available on-line

26 January – 9 February:

- On-going research and discussions with Form Tutor, Teachers, Careers and Parents/Carers.

9 February:

- Application deadline

February – April:

- Recruitment process including subject tasters, course meetings and offers

Thursday 22 August 2024: Results Day and Decision Day!
