Dear Parents, Carers

Firstly, a huge thank you for the welcome and support that you have give me in my first few months here. One of the key ways I have improved schools previously is by using the summer term to raise standards in a clear and meaningful way. Weston Favell is already a strong school, but we can make further improvements if we work together.

After half term, pupils in Years 7, 8 and 9 will use a single exercise book for each subject. This will contain all lesson work and will be **brought home every day**. This gives you a valuable opportunity to see your child's learning on a daily basis and engage more closely with their progress. Throughout the final half term, we will be celebrating the quality of work and effort pupils show in their books.

This approach increases transparency, allowing you to see how your child is engaging in lessons, while also helping us maintain consistently high standards across all classes.

#### **What we need from you:**

- Please ensure your child brings a suitable bag each day to transport their exercise book safely. Most pupils already do this, but if you would like support with this, please contact us at [admin@westonfavellacademy.org](mailto:admin@westonfavellacademy.org).
- Form tutors will check books weekly, and there will be space for you to communicate with us. We encourage you to regularly look through your child's work and use this space where appropriate—this will help us raise standards and celebrate their efforts together.
- We will also be asking pupils to record whether they have completed their homework which is set for English, Maths and Science using Sparx.

Alongside our One Book Strategy, we will be trialling homework support sessions. These will be allocated via Class Charts when a pupil misses three or more pieces of homework in a core subject. The support sessions are designed to help support pupils to complete the missed work and will also provide subject-specific specialist support. You can support this by encouraging regular homework completion, checking Class Charts, and ensuring attendance at sessions where required.

Success will look different for each pupil, but this is a valuable opportunity for every young person to demonstrate high standards in their work over the final half term.

The most important way to support this initiative is by ensuring your child attends school every day and by taking time to engage with their work at home. This is a great opportunity to share in their learning and celebrate their progress.
