

WFA Sixth Form Learning Agreement

The Sixth Form Learning Agreement states the responsibilities of both individual learners and the Academy. It is intended to enable every student to achieve their academic and personal potential within a supportive and positive learning environment.

You can expect from the Sixth Form:

- Staff to be polite and treat you courteously as a Sixth Form student and senior member of the school
- A student-centered and supportive environment which celebrates equality and diversity and has embedded strategies to support and promote well-being
- High quality lessons with regular setting and prompt marking of formal work which clearly sets targets for improvement
- A comprehensive PSHE programme of information, advice and guidance to support effective transitions, students' personal development and an understanding of our responsibilities as global citizens
- The provision of places where students can work in a calm and cared-for environment
- A varied extra-curricular offer providing opportunities to develop soft skills, leadership and reflection
- Commitment to hearing the student voice through regular student-managed Focus Group meetings

As a Sixth Form student you will be expected to:

- Be kind and considerate towards other students and staff at all times
- Act as a positive role model both for younger students in the school and across the wider community
- Attend lessons, assemblies and Form time punctually as expected, aiming to achieve 100% but with a minimum of 96% attendance across the academic year
- Complete work to the required standard and deadlines
- Accept responsibility for your own learning and ensure that the learning and working of others is not disrupted
- Inform your Form Tutor and Mrs Whelan of the reasons for any absence; holidays are not to be taken during term time
- Present yourself professionally and dress according to the Sixth Form Dress code
- Contribute to the three aspects of Global Citizenship: school community; local community and global community
- Show respect for the Sixth Form environment
- Limit the numbers of hours used for part-time employment (National Union of Student guidelines state 8 hours is maximum advised)
- Wear your lanyard at all times in accordance with Academy Safe-Guarding policies

I have read the Learning Agreement and will make every effort to meet the expectations of the Sixth Form in order to uphold the Sixth Form ethos and achieve my full potential. I understand that failure to do so may result in the Sixth Form 'Report and Support Process' being evoked. In the most serious scenario, my Sixth Form place may be withdrawn.
