QU 1. What has been completed, so far, in years 10/11 in SPORT SCIENCE?

AN 1. So far in years 10/11, the following work has been completed and assessed...

- R041 Reducing the Risk of Injuries
 - This is the examination unit. Students have completed (in year 10) a series of mock exams. An average grade has been awarded for this unit based on the results achieved by all students ranging from P1 – D2.
- R042 Fitness
 - This is a coursework unit.
 - MOST students have completed this unit. The unit has been marked by the teacher and this unit has been internally moderated in school. Students have been awarded a grade from P1 – D2 for this unit.
- R043 Anatomy & Physiology
 - Due to lockdowns and a reduction of time that students have spent in school, OCR the exam board, have allowed schools to `drop` a unit of work. We have dropped this unit.

QU 2. What have students still got to complete in Year 11 in SPORT SCIENCE?

AN 2. All students in Year 11 still have to complete R044 SPORTS PSYCHOLOGY

- All students in year 11 have started R044
- This is a coursework unit.
- Students will complete this unit of work and it will be internally marked and moderated. Grades will be awarded from P1 – D2.
- Once this unit is completed, the exam board will ask for a `sample` of work to be externally moderated. This could be in January or May of 2022 (depending on when students complete this work).
- The exam board completes this external moderation to ensure that all schools have assessed the work accurately.

All students have been provided with example material for this unit of work so that they are aware of the standards needed to achieve their Target Grade. Examples of work are provided at the `Steps to Success` evening. Please feel free to take some samples.
