

# **Extended Writing Questions**

#### The 8 mark question!

- Make a couple of bullet points in each box you will get credit for these bullet points – up to 3 or 4 marks. This is really worth doing!
- 2. Then structure your piece of writing like this:
- A short introduction to summarise the question.
- A paragraph to discuss the pros.
- A paragraph to discuss the cons.
- A conclusion make a decision on the pro or con and say why you have drawn that conclusion.

You will gain marks for keeping to the point and making a persuasive argument.
