# Assessment:

Paper 1: Literary prose unseen – 1 hour and 45 minutes (50%)

Paper 2: Non-Fiction extracts unseen – 1 hour and 45 minutes (50%)

English Language is now exclusively assessed through the means of a terminal examination and no longer has a controlled assessment module as part of the qualification. For the final grade, students will sit two external examinations based on unseen literary and non-literary prose extracts from a variety of time periods and genres. They must understand how to analyse structure, language and meaning in detail and will then have to produce a piece of their own in the same literary style.
